Q. Can you name a male physician who graduated from Fatima Jinnah Medical College?

Dr. Basheer had just finished his medical studies at the Amritsar Medical College in Punjab, India. After partition of the subcontinent, the students were given opportunities to graduate from one of the medical schools in Pakistan. Dr. Basheer was one of those students and graduated from the Fatima Jinnah Medical College in 1949.

Dr. Basheer had a very successful practice in Raheem Yar Khan. He was also involved in the local and regional politics.

Dr. Basheer and Nasim Akhtar had nine children including Tayabba. Amjad and Tayabba have been married since 1975. Dr. Zaheer is practicing Radiology in Canton, IL. They have three children: Ammara, Bilal and Rabie.
